lies who otherwise may not be able to send their children to Busy Bees due to cost. There is an application process and recipients will be screened and chosen anonymously by the Busy Bees Board.

Monday, April 10, Lura Jean Chandler will be Discussing *Unsinkable Debbie Reynolds* by Debbie Reynolds.





SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

Session met on March 5, 2017 for its regular stated meeting with Dr. Henley moderating the meeting.

<u>Busy Bees</u>- 16 children are enrolled for the Pre-School with 3 Staff members hired. An anonymous gift has been made to provide \$1800 in scholarship aid as needed.

<u>Adult Nurture-</u> Coordinating with the Upper Long Cane Presbyterian Church for Easter sunrise services on April 16th. WFW was held as fundraiser for the youth on Feb 15th and Maundy Thursday will be April 13th.

<u>Children and Youth Nurture</u>- Upcoming events are Youth Sunday service on March 11th, Joint Easter Egg hunt with Main Street Methodist on April 15th, and getting more involved with the Abbeville Youth Center.

<u>Building and Grounds</u>- Announced the upgrade of thermostats at the Church.

<u>Finance and Administration</u>- Session Voted to not dissolve a Certificate of Deposit until the APC foundation meets and develops a direction or investment strategy; but list the CD as an asset. They then passed, unanimously, a balanced 2017 proposed budget of \$203,109.61.

<u>Mission and Evangelism</u>- The following was presented: Lenten services of Music, Meditation, and Prayer will be from 12:00 until 12:20 each Wednesday with Joe Greer's organ and piano music. Dr. Henley's installation service will be at 4:00 pm on Mar 12th.

<u>Old Business</u>- Robin Stalnaker reported that Suzie Sherard had been installed as Vice-moderator of Trinity Presbytery and APC's term of call to Dr. Henley were both approved at the recent Presbytery meeting held in Greenwood, SC.

<u>New Business</u>- Session approved that they will meet on the first Sunday of each month. Session also voted unanimously to establish Stewardship as a separate committee, chaired by Merry Trask, and comprised of at least one member from each of the other committees.

She was nominated by the Presbytery nominating committee and took the office at the February 18th Presbytery meeting.



Please keep Suzie in your prayers as she commits herself to this leadership role which allows this part of the Presbytery to be represented.






